Child Nutrition Report 2024:

- It was released by UNICEF.
- This global report examines the status, trends, inequities, and drivers of child food poverty in early childhood, including the impact of global and local food and nutrition crises.
- UNICEF defines child food povertyas children'sinability to accessand consume anutritious and diverse diet in early childhood(i.e., the first five years of life).

Highlights of the 2024 Report:

- One in four children under age 5 around the world (some 27% of children under age 5 or 181 million) is experiencing severe food poverty and is vulnerable to life-threatening malnutrition.
- Over two-thirds of the 181 millionyoung children living in severe food povertylive in South Asia and sub-Saharan Africa, with 20 countries accounting for 65% of the children living in severe food poverty.
