## Why in news?

Recently, the <u>Indian Navy</u> announced the <u>second women circumnavigation expedition</u> and unveiled the expedition logo.

- Two Indian Navy women officers, Lt Cdr Roopa A and Lt Cdr Dilna K, will embark on a globe-circumnavigating expedition known as Navika Sagar Parikrama II, onboard INSV Tarini.
- Women Navy officers are being guided by Cdr Abhilash Tomy (Retd.), a renowned circumnavigator and Golden Globe Racehero.
- Golden Globe Race is a prestigious solo sailing competition to circumnavigate the globe without stopping and using only traditional navigation methods.
- In the Navika Sagar Parikramalogo, the octagonal shape in the center depicts the Indian Navy, while the sun signifies acelestial body and the compass, guiding the sailors through the challenging seas.
- Previous Expeditions of Indian Navy:
- A trans-oceanic voyage from Goa to Rio de Janeiro via Cape Town and back.
- A sailing expedition from Goa to Sri Vijaya Puram (formerly Port Blair) and back.
- A sortie from Goa to Port Louis, Mauritius.

## **AboutINS Tarini**

- The Indian Naval Sailing Vessel (INSV) Tarini is the second sailboat of the Indian Navy after INSV Mhedi.
- It was constructed at Aquarius Shipyard located in Goa.
- After undergoing extensive sea trials, she was commissioned to Indian Navy service on 18 February 2017.
- It is known for circumnavigating the globe with an all-women officer crew in the historic expedition titled 'Navika Sagar Parikrama' in 2017.
