- 2. **Sea Phase**: The sea phase is focused on actual combat operations at sea. This phase will include:
- Combat Operations: Simulating scenarios to test operational strategies and tactics in maritime warfare.
- Cyber and Electronic Warfare: A critical component to address emerging threats in the cyber domain and electronic warfare (EW) operations.
- Live Weapon Firings: Real-time firing of weapons to simulate actual combat conditions.
- Amphibious Exercise (AMPHEX): Testing the ability to launch amphibious operations, which involves the coordination of land and naval forces.

- The exercise is crucial for improving the **jointness** between the **Indian Navy**, **Indian Army**, **Indian Air Force**, and the **Indian Coast Guard**, which are all involved in TROPEX.
